PITCHDECK (MODE: OFFLINE)

- Eligibility: The competition is open to Undergraduate (UG) and Postgraduate (PG) students.
- Solutions should be original and innovative. Any form of plagiarism will lead to disqualification.
- Each team will be allotted 5 minutes for presentation, followed by 2 minutes for Q&A.
- The pitch must clearly cover the following components: Problem, Solution, Market Potential, Sustainability Impact (SDG linkage), and Feasibility.
- Participants must use a Power Point presentation (PPT) to support their pitch. The presentation must be mailed to fatimahonoursacca@gmail.com on or before January 31, 2026. Late submissions will not be accepted.
